4. Read Matthew 27:26-56. When you look at Matthew's description of the suffering and humiliation Jesus endured, what person or group stands out to you in the way they treated Jesus?
5. Read Matthew 18:1-10. What stands out to you in Matthew's account of the first Easter Sunday?
6. What Easter details from the other gospel writers not found in Matthew have impacted you over the years?
7. Jesus said He came to seek and to save the lost in Luke 19:10. How have you sensed Jesus searching for you in your life?
